





2006-2010 Total Admissions





Saint Barnabas Heart Center at CMC

- Joint Commission certification for Acute Coronary Syndrome (first in New Jersey) in April 2011

- Emergent Angioplasty 132 procedures in 2010; 31 in 2011 (#1 in state for non-cardiac surgery hospitals)

- Congestive Heart Failure Program, Cardiac Home;
 Monitoring/Telehealth
- Cardiac Rehab Program
- Outpatient Services: Echo, EKG, 64–Slice CT
- Pacemaker Program

 - 1,000 stroke cases annually
- Dedicated neuro inpatient unit
- Centers for Sleep Disorders (only accredited program in Ocean County)
- Video EEG program for the diagnosis of seizure disorders
- Become Comprehensive Stroke Center by providing community based neurosurgical interventions at CMC
- Elevate epilepsy care
- Participate/lead community based neuroscience research in Alzheimer's

Support From our Community

- Auxiliary Association
 - CMC Auxiliary Association raises over \$300,000 annually
 - Since its founding in 1954, the Auxiliary has given \$9.7 million to support programs and services at CMC
 - Over 350 active members
 - Operating two shops—Second Time Around Consignment Shop and CMC Gift Shop

- CMC Foundation has raised \$2 million annually over the past 5 years
